



Reversible Baby Bib

in Basic Stitch

REVERSIBLE BABY BIB in BS 101

Infant size

Left over Worsted 4 ply yarns DC and LC.

1.Ch 23 with DC. 2. PU sts. 3. TH, add LC, CHO 10 in BS, to dec at center, YO, pull through 4 loops tog,(that is 1 ch and 3 bars tog) Tighten the 3 tog, CHO last 10 sts. Fig. 1

NOTE:

To keep edges neat and tight at end of each CHO row, pull the yarn of last bar tight while you start the PU row. And also tighten the first PU st.

4. PU 10 sts with LC, insert hook through the 3 tog as 1 BS, YO, pull through, PU last 10 sts.

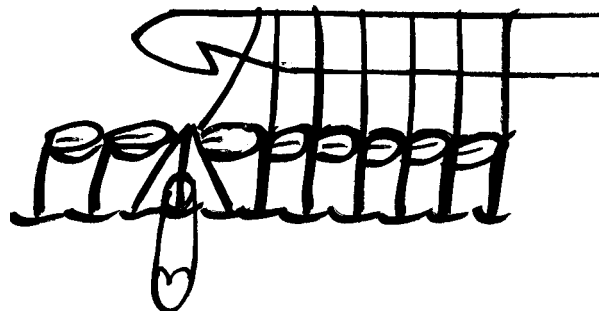
5.TH, CHO with DC, **WITHOUT** dec. 6. PU sts with DC. 7. TH, CHO 9 sts with LC, dec in center, CHO last 9 sts. There is 1 st less on each side of center dec. Use a safety pin to mark dec, count carefully to dec exactly in center on LC CHO row. Move pin up as needed. Fig.2

8.Rep steps 4 thru 7 until there are 11 sts at end of DC PU row. 9. TH, CHO with LC. 10.Bind off on LC PU row, ch 1 at corner. **DO NOT CUT LC.** Cut DC 3" long and tie to edge.

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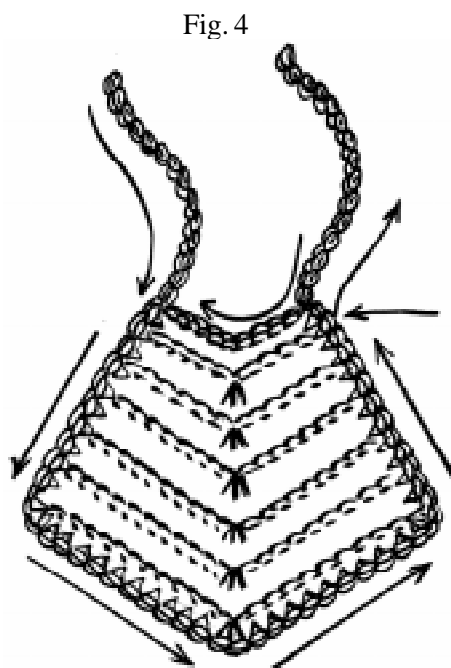
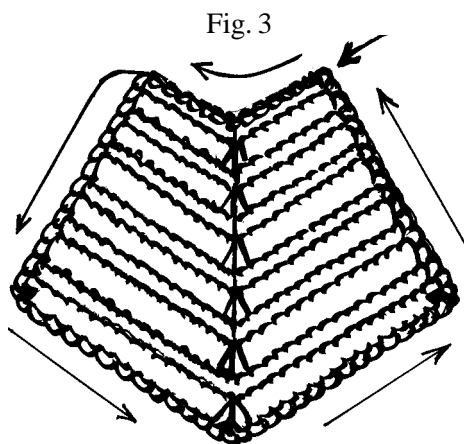
EDGE AROUND

11. Do 1 sc at corner going under 2 strands of DC. Do 1 sc under 2 strands of LC, do a total of 10 sc to next corner, add 1 more sc at corner. Go along starting edge with 1 sc under 2 strands of DC, where the yarns cross each other, do 10 sc on each side with 2 sc at the point, go on to next corner and do 2 sc. Go along side edge with 10 sc to match the other side. Cut LC yarn and hide end through same color work. Fig. 3

TIES

12. Hold DC side of bib toward you. Use DC, insert hook at right corner of neckline and pull a loop through, ch 30 sts and sl st over each ch, going under 1 strand, to starting point. Sl st over bound off neckline, skip st in center for better fit. At left corner ch 30 sts and sl st back to corner.

Continue around with sl st, going under 2 strands of each sc to join at starting point with sl st. Cut yarn and hide end. Fig. 4



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
